Every day, each lesson is represented by a letter in the word "H.E.L.P.S." Today we're going to learn letter "H" which stands for "Love Heals Others' Hurts." Our Bible story today is about how people responded to a man who was hurt. Day 1 Bible Story: The Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37) Memory Verse: "Love your neighbor as yourself." Galatians 5:14b	Can anyone tell me what the "H" stood for yesterday (Heals Other's Hurts)? Today, we're going to learn letter "E" which stands for "Encourage Others." Our Bible story today is about friends who strengthened their leader in battle. Day 2 Bible Story: The Amalekites are defeated with Moses' hands held up (Exodus 17:8-16) Memory Verse: "Therefore encourage one another and build each other up." 1 Thessalonians 5:11a	Today we're going to learn letter "L" which stands for "Lends a Hand to Others." Lending a hand means helping another person do something that they couldn't accomplish by themselves. Today we're going to hear a Bible story about some men who used their hands and feet to lend a hand to their friend. Day 3 Bible Story: Friends of a paralyzed man (Mark 2:1-12) Memory Verse: "A friend loves at all times." Proverbs 17:17a	Can anyone remind us what "H," "E," and "L" stand for (Heals Other's Hurts, Encourages Others, and Lends a Hand)? Today we're going to learn letter "P" which stands for "Prays for Others." According to the Bible, praying for others is a very powerful way that you can help them. Today we're going to hear a Bible story about the power of prayer to the one true God! Day 4 Bible Story: Elijah on Mount Carmel with the altar (1 Kings 18:16-39) Memory Verse: "The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective." James 5:16b	Can anyone remind us what "H," "E," "L," and "P" stand for (Heals Other's Hurts, Encourages Others, Lends a Hand, and Prays for Others)? Today we're going to learn letter "S" which stands for "Love Sacrifices for Others." Day 5 Bible Story: The Death & Resurrection of Jesus (Luke 23:26-24:8) Memory Verse: "Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth." 1 John 3:18
